Meeting Proceeded at 12:15 p.m. at Clary's Grille.

- Is there a need for hats at this year's annual fund raising shoot? Inventory check will need to be done on what we have for an existing stock and whether or not additional hats will need to be ordered.
- Pricing was set for advertisement in our monthly newsletter. It is as follows:
 - 1/8 page \$120/yr (9 month distribution)
 - 1/4 page \$180/yr (9 month distribution)
 - 1/2 page \$220/yr (9 month distribution)
 - Full page \$250/yr (9 month distribution)
- All items CRC
 - Catering menu is still outstanding, but will not be set until closer to the event.
 - Peppermill has sent a tentative scheduling of events. Verification will be needed.
 - A reminder will be sent out at a minimum of 6 weeks before the event to all Area X chapters.
 - CRC planning has been placed on hold until June or July (Great work Jace and Candice)
 - We are still actively looking for national suppliers' interest in CRC donations in the form of booths and/or banners, etc.
